**Submission of pesticides samples for quality assurance programme**

Furthermore to the Circular No RP/2015-02 on 07.08.2015 for above subject.

I would like to bring to notice of the following procedures of the pesticide quality assurance programs adopted by office of the Registrar of pesticides with immediate effect.

01. It is necessary to submit following documents with the 1 g /1 ml standard during the registration process

- Certificate of analysis with assay report, including uncertainty and traceability values and relevant expire information issued by authorized signatories

Above reports should be generated by product testing accredited laboratory

02. As you are aware samples sent to the ROP office, have been kept in the laboratory for 2 months period only. After two months period samples are ready for disposal. But ROP laboratory do not have technology to dispose the remaining pesticides sample. Therefore please make notice that remaining samples will be resend to the relevant companies for disposal. Procedure is as follows.

- On the first Wednesday of every month during 9.30-12.00 a.m. Each company should be collecting their remaining samples after analysis from the analytical Laboratory of ROP office.
- Otherwise, Analytical laboratory of registrar of pesticide office will not be issuing market clearance till the collecting of remaining samples is done.
- Companies are responsible to transport the remaining sample for their ware houses to dispose them in proper way.
- ROP advice you that, these samples are not for share, sale, or promote among people and only for disposal.
- After above process, each company is responsible for issuing a letter indicating 'samples are kept on safe way in their premises.'

03. Please be good enough to fill the customer feedback form and please send it to ROP office on or before 31.01.2016(Copy is attached)

04. Please notice that tared, broken or leaking samples are not eligible for analysis.  
Please make sure that the samples are in good condition and pack in safe manner.
